High School:

Each student (9-12) must carry a minimum of seven classes per semester; these may include any of the electives listed below for your grade. Any course may be taken any year after it is first offered if the pre-requisites are met. No more than one physical education course per semester may be counted toward a student's seven classes. Exemptions will be granted to seniors for the following reasons: 1) students who are taking any two of the following weighted courses: AP course, Advanced Biology, Calculus, PACC course, Physics; 2) for the purpose of this policy, Youth Apprenticeship (YA) program participation will count as one class; 3) no one will be permitted to engage in more than 1 YA program in any semester.
